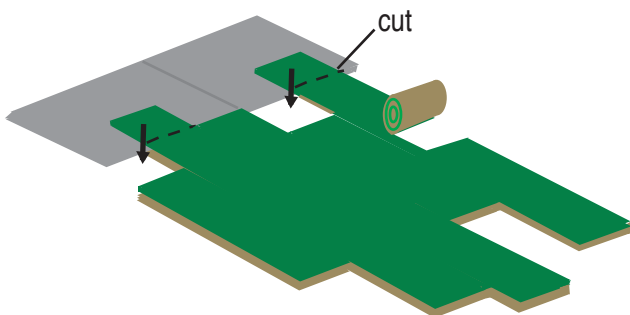


Installation



Prepare ground before laying sod.
(smooth dirt...smooth lawn!)

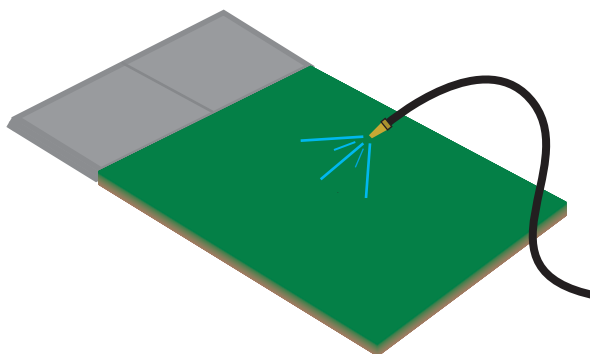
Begin laying sod next to a straight edge
like a sidewalk or driveway.

Stagger the rolls to create a "Brick"
affect. This will keep seam lines
to a minimum.

Pull edges together tightly to eliminate
seams and prevent drying.

Water as you go.

Initial Care



IMPORTANT! Sod is perishable!
Install quickly and begin watering.

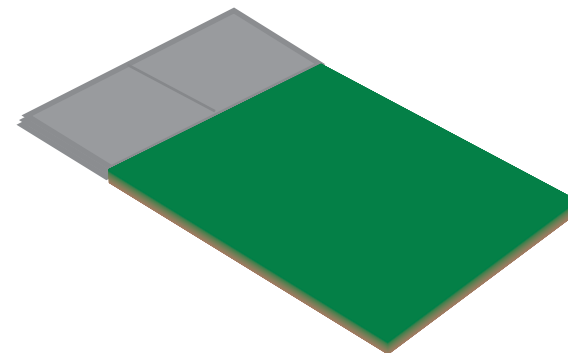
During the first week, water three times
daily for 10-15 minutes. If water begins
to puddle, cut back watering times.

During the second week, water twice
daily for 10-15 minutes.

After two weeks, your lawn should be
established well enough to begin
normal watering and use.

These recommendations might need
to be altered depending on soil type,
slope and weather conditions.

Maintenance



For best results, spread a balanced mix
fertilizer on bare dirt before laying sod.

Thereafter, fertilize around the three
summer holidays, Memorial Day,
Fourth of July, and Labor Day.

Allow two weeks before mowing. A
cutting height of 1 1/2 - 2 inches will
help maintain a healthy, beautiful lawn.
